### MERCY, FAITH, LOVE

Ministries in the Diocese of Nashville affect and enhance family life for those in need of assistance in our community. Our ministries provide guidance and show mercy to those in need of the services of Calvary Cemetery, those in prison, those fighting to be able to continue our faith traditions, our seniors in need of housing or assisted-living facilities, families in need of shelter, hot food, clothing, and those in need of a Catholic Summer Camp for their children.

Jesus taught us that we live our faith — and proclaim the Gospel — when we are channels for God’s love, working to transform human suffering and build societies that prioritize human dignity, care for creation, and the common good.

We must nourish our faith, Pope Francis writes, so it can illumine our lives and the world we live in. Faith doesn’t “draw us away from the world or prove irrelevant to the concrete concerns” facing humanity. Instead, it means “building in charity a city based on relationships,” with God’s love as the foundation (*Lumen Fidei*, no. 51).

These ministries have a far-reaching impact on the communities of Middle Tennessee.

#### “SHARING YOUR BREAD WITH THE HUNGRY,

Catholic Charities of Tennessee, Inc. nourishes the faithful with physical and spiritual bread through its many programs: providing humanitarian aid to refugees, caring for our elderly through adult daycare, providing community meals for the hungry and food distributions through the basic needs program, and much more.

We also provide spiritual bread through our prison ministry, chaplain ministry, and church ministry programs.

#### SHELTERING THE OPPRESSED AND THE HOMELESS,

We in the Diocese of Nashville provide assisted living, low-income housing for families and



seniors, and independent housing for families in support of Nashville’s affordable housing initiative. Catholic Charities also has services in support of the initiative that aims to end family homelessness, along with refugee services.

#### CLOTHING THE NAKED,

Spiritual clothing is provided through nearly every ministry in the diocese. Child abuse prevention and counseling are ways we can clothe those who are naked, or in danger, with safety. Adult formation, campus ministry, lay ministry training and religious education provide, for many, the armor of knowledge of our faith.

There are also opportunities to provide physical clothes to the needy through coat drives, Christmas Wishes program, and outreach programs.

Youth ministries, CYO, Saint Mary Child Development Center, SEARCH, Camp Marymount, and other ministries strengthen the faith of our youth. These ministries provide opportunities to act in faith by volunteering and becoming involved in our community and Church.

Supporting the grieving, setting free the oppressed, assisting those in need, and caring for our children are all a part of our ministries. Together we can provide for those around us that are in need.
